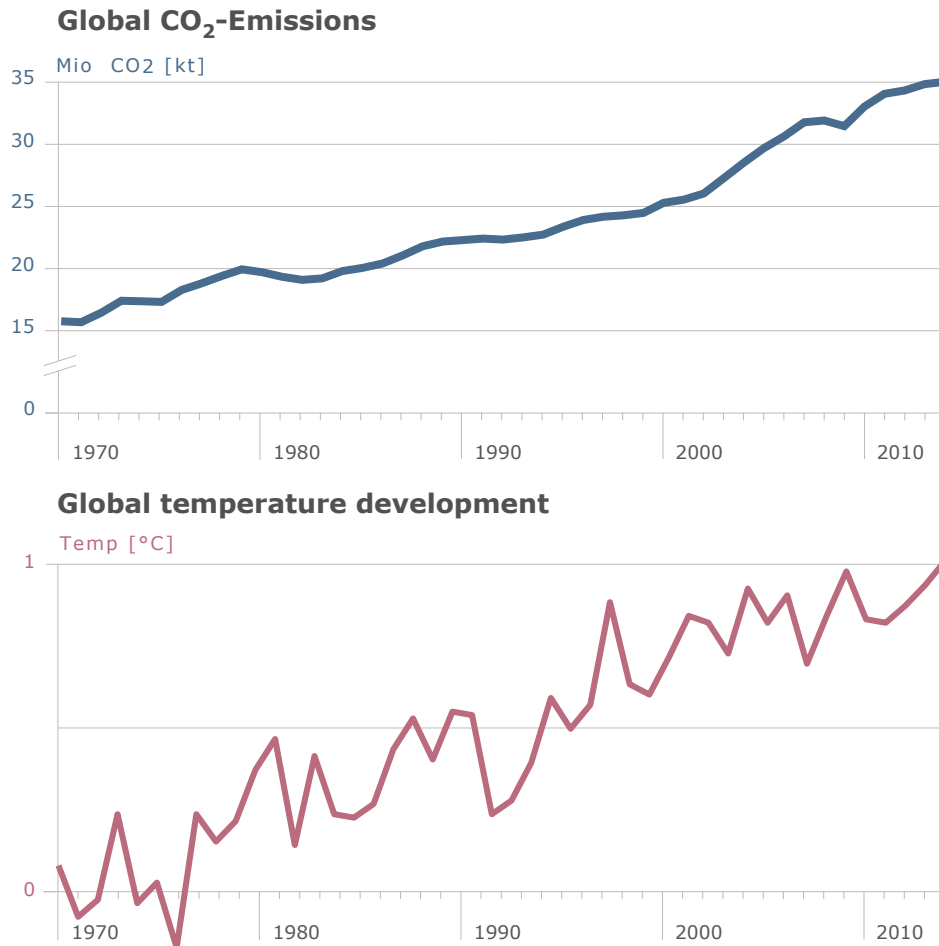


CO₂-Emissions und temperature development 1970-2014

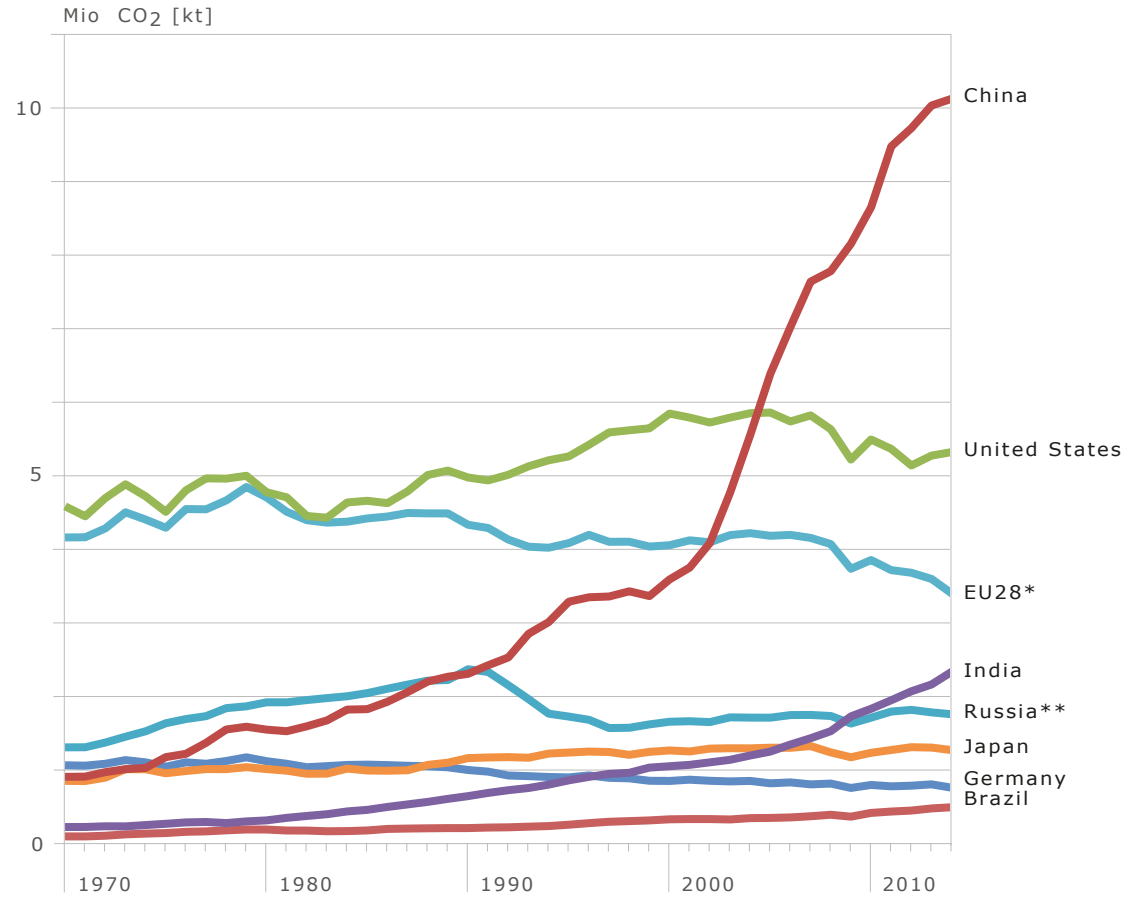
Global values and selected countries in comparison
